### **MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD AT THE EDWARD EDWARDS LIBRARY, NITON, ON MONDAY 14<sup>th</sup> MAY 2018 AT 7:00 PM**

#### **1. WELCOME BY THE CHAIRMAN**

The Chairman welcomed all present to the meeting.

#### **2. MINUTES**

Those present had before them the minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017.

**RESOLVED:** that the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017 be confirmed and signed as an accurate record of the proceedings.

#### **3. MATTERS ARISING**

There were no matters arising.

#### **4. ANNUAL REPORT**

Those present had before them a copy of the Annual Report on the activities of the Council for 2017/18 (see copy attached).

**RESOLVED:** that the Annual Report of the Council be received and noted.

Councillor Stewart reported on his concerns regarding the car parked repeatedly outside the Allotment Road car park and stated that he would be monitoring the situation.

Reference was made to potential changes to the Niton Football Club development s106 agreement; the Football Club and developer were considering the means by which the £40,000 contribution, secured by the s106 agreement, may be provided by the developer.

**RESOLVED:** that the Football Club development s106 agreement be included on the agenda for discussion at the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council to be held on 21<sup>st</sup> May.

#### **5. FINANCIAL REPORT**

Those present had before them a copy of the internally audited accounts for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018.

**RESOLVED:** that the Annual Accounts be received and noted.

**6. LOCAL MEMBER’S REPORT ON THE ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCIL**

Councillor Stewart reported that the past year had been his first since re-election and as Leader of the Isle of Wight Council. He had maintained his engagement with both Parish Councils within the Ward, attending as many meetings as possible.

Councillor Stewart stated that he was currently involved with many local issues including planning, the re-instatement of Undercliff Drive, local road resurfacing, Community Action Road Safety (CARS) initiatives, Niton Football Club new clubhouse facilities and speeding along the Military Road. He also outlined several major issues with which the Isle of Wight Council was currently engaged.

RESOLVED: that Councillor Stewart’s report be received and noted.

Those present thanked Councillor Stewart for taking time to attend the meeting.

**7. COMMENTS, REQUESTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ELECTORS**
